SNAP/EBT (Food Stamps) Updates through September 2021:

- SNAP benefits will provide about \$28 more per person, per month, or more than \$100 more per month for a household of four in additional SNAP benefits.
- Extension of the PANDEMIC EBT (P-EBT) PROGRAM
 through the summer, which provides families benefit
 dollars to buy groceries to make up for meals missed
 when schools are closed.
- TEMPORARY expansion of SNAP eligibility for students enrolled at least half-time in an institution of higher education, who meet qualifications.
